The totals for the inmate characteristics contained in this report, with the exception of the sex distribution table, represent the OBSCIS I system data available for the respective categories on the date of the report. The totals on the Sex Distribution table represents the manual total population on the date the report is prepared. Differences between categories are due to missing data on the automated system. Information for an additional 281 inmates housed in local jails, Pre-trial and P&P Home Detention and MCAC Federal contract is not available.

As of April 2007, race categories on the report are consistent with OBSCIS I modifications and reflect federal NCIC race codes. The inclusion of Asian and Unknown categories on the report has resulted in a small change in category percentages.
